

Good afternoon from Linda Maness at Susan G. Komen, Development Manager for VT/NH.

With one week to go until the 2022 Komen New Hampshire Snowshoe, Saturday, Feb. 5, I am contacting you to say that we have made the difficult decision to make the NH Snowshoe a “virtual” event.

From the 2022 Komen New Hampshire FAQ section of our event website:

Is this event subject cancellation due to weather?

The 2022 Komen New Hampshire Snowshoe is subject to cancellation in the event of major winter snowstorm or dangerous cold temperatures. Any cancellation announcement will be made by e-mail by Friday evening, Feb 4; AND will be posted on Facebook in the [2022 Komen New England Snowshoe Events](#) group.

While the cancellation of this event is not due to weather (although it is supposed to be cold NEXT weekend), we feel that due to Covid-19 and therefore a mostly virtual registration body, we do need to cancel the in-person event.

Q. What does this mean for you as a NH Snowshoe registrant?

A. While Susan G. Komen will not be hosting an onsite snowshoe course at The Glen House in Gorham, you are invited to snowshoe at the neighboring **Great Glen Trails Outdoor Center**, for free, when you mention you are a Komen New Hampshire registrant. Should you need snowshoes, it is my understanding that rental will be free as well.

Q. How do I get my event T-shirt? Where?

A. For those you who indicated at the time of registration that you wish to be recognized as a survivor or someone living with metastatic disease, and for our registrants who have raised \$50 or more as of Feb. 1:

I will be at The Glen House on Friday, Feb. 4, between 4-6 PM, to handout these T-shirts and any other Fundraising Recognition items (for those raising \$250 or more by Feb. 3).

NOTE: Should you bring in new (offline) donations on Friday, these donations will COUNT toward your fundraising effort and recognition awards.

Q. “I’m coming from out of town, but not staying at The Glen House on Friday night. How do I get my T-shirt and/or fundraising recognition?”

A. I will be available at The Glen House (lobby) Saturday morning between 8:30-9:00 AM and then over at Great Glen Trails Outdoor Center between 9:30-10 AM. You will be able to pick up your event T-shirt and any earned fundraising recognition items.

On behalf of Susan G. Komen and the New Hampshire Snowshoe, I thank you for registering and making a plan to snowshoe, and especially, for fundraising.

A “New Hampshire Silent Auction by e-mail” will be held between February 10-14. FYI, our recent post-event “VT Snowshoe Silent Auction by e-mail” brought in more than \$1000 in winning bids.
